GPAC Tier 1

University Gen Ed Requirements

- 1 course in **quantitative reasoning** in mathematics or statistics
- 1 course in **scientific reasoning** in natural and/or physical lab sciences
- 2 courses in **critical thinking** in the social sciences
- 1 course in **critical thinking** in the humanities
- 1 first year **writing** course (UW 1020)
- 2 writing in the discipline courses*

 *must be taken after completion of UW 1020 to count
- 1 course in **oral communication**

GPAC Tier 2

CCAS Gen Ed Requirements

- 1 course in **creative** or **critical thinking** in the arts
- 1 additional **scientific reasoning** course in natural and/or physical lab sciences
- 1 additional **critical thinking** course in the humanities
- 1 course that includes a **global** or **cross-cultural perspective**
- 1 course that includes a **local/civic** engagement perspective

General GPAC Policies

- Courses taken to fulfill any of the Tier One and Tier Two requirements, except UW 1020, may also be counted toward a major
- Credit by examination (AP, IB) and pre-matriculation transfer credit can count toward GPAC if approved as a GPAC equivalent course
- Once a student has matriculated, all remaining GPAC courses must be done in residence (approved study abroad courses taken during the fall and spring semesters can be considered in residence)
- Courses taken prior to the semesters they were approved for GPAC do not count towards GPAC
