

MSTD Oral Presentation Requirement

Each student enrolled in the Museum Studies MA or On-Campus Certificate Program, must make a presentation on his or her required internship. The requirement takes effect for students entering the program in fall 2013 and after.

***This requirement is not optional.
You must complete this requirement in order to receive
your MA or On-Campus Certificate.***

Presentation Guidelines

- Presentations should be approximately 7 minutes long plus 3 minutes for questions
- Presentations should include PowerPoints or other visuals
- Besides a summary of your internship, also consider topics such as what you learned, what worked well, and what didn't work well, etc.
- Presentations will be given to a committee comprised of two MSTD Full-Time Faculty members (also in attendance will be the other presenters and MSTD students who wish to observe)
- The Committee will provide feedback by email to the presenter as well as a **pass/fail grade**

General Presentation Schedule

- Internships completed during the fall semester, should be presented the following spring semester
- Internships completed during the spring semester, should be presented the following summer semester
- Internships completed during the summer semester, should be presented the following fall semester
